To conjure up a job in a school or college



Tip 1 – Think about what you want

- What age group do you want to work with?
- Where do you want to be based?
- What type of job do you want?
- What type of work? (Full time, part time etc.)



Tip 2 – Research, research, research

- Look at jobs in your area
- Speak to schools and colleges
- Speak to friends who work in schools
- View job vacancies and see what qualifications you might need

Tip 3 – Volunteer to work with children or young people

- Schools value experience (paid or voluntary) Community groups and other ightarrow

Tip 4 – Use your transferable skills

- Use parent/carer power this is relevant!
- Organisation skills, team work and communication
- Think about past employment and volunteering



Tip 5 – Apply for a vacancy

- Update your CV
- Speak to schools or colleges you've volunteered at first
- Visit the Portsmouth City Council jobs portal and search for 'school jobs'
- Subscribe to the Teach Portsmouth newsletter
- Extend your search to other places



Tip 6 – Apply for an apprenticeship

- Apprenticeships are a good option to build experience and gain a qualification
- The Learning Place, City of Portsmouth College and HSDC can support you
- Options to gain level two maths and English qualifications, if needed
- Go to 'findapprenticeship.service.gov.uk'
