

- We administer early education funding to support families with their childcare costs:



Role of a School Crossing Patroller

- ▶ Being a School Crossing Patroller for Portsmouth City Council ensures that all members of the public cross the road safely at the designated crossing point.
- ➤ You will play a huge role in children's lives by ensuring them that using a School Crossing Patroller to cross the road is the safest point of call
- ➤ You will also put a lot of parents at ease as they know their child will be safe crossing the road to get to school, especially when they are starting their independent skills.

Working Hours

► This role is term time only, 2 hours per day (1 hour in the morning and 1 hour in the afternoon).

► There is the added bonus of being paid for all the school holidays (T+C apply).

Training

- ► Full training will be given
- ➤ You will complete a minimum of 1 week's training/shadowing with an experienced School Crossing Patroller on site.

Uniform

You will be provided with all the uniform necessary for all weather conditions:

- Winter Coat
- Summer Jacket
- Winter Hat
- Summer Cap
- Winter Gloves
- ► Lollypop stick and bag
